ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

All of us at Iken Barns are passionate about our impact on our beautiful surroundings here on the Suffolk Heritage coast. We are making a conscious effort to reduce our carbon footprint on the local area and hope you are willing to help us too.

We try to adopt and kindly ask you to consider the following:

- Keep Noise to a minimum
- Close your curtains when it is dusk or dark during cooler times to retain heat within your property
- Turn down your thermostat if you are too warm
- Do not leave your appliances on standby
- Remember to turn the lights off every time you leave an empty room
- Only boil as much water as you need to use
- Make sure the taps are not dripping
- Ensure your dishwasher/ washing machine is full when you start it
- Separate (and rinse when necessary) your recyclable products, plastic, paper, glass etc. We can collect these on your departure or please use the bins provided.
- Don't forget the wildlife with any suitable excess food especially during the winter months
- Sheets and towels are washed between guests to reduce washing. We line dry items when appropriate
- The Barns have been well insulated to reduce heat loss, please respect this and keep doors and windows closed as much as possible during the cooler months.
